

I. POLICY STATEMENT

University of Florida (UF) strives to provide students, faculty, and staff with disabilities an open and welcoming campus by eliminating barriers and continually striving to improve the seamless accessibility of our campus, programs, and activities to include those individuals involved in Graduate Medical Education (GME). . Part of this commitment is to assure equal opportunity in employment and education for individuals with disabilities.

II. REASON FOR POLICY

This policy establishes guidelines for ensuring all UF GME programs are compliant with disability-related law, including the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

III. SCOPE

This policy applies to all training programs accredited by the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME), or approved by the American Board of Medical Specialties (ABMS), and/or sponsored by the UF College of Medicine.

IV. PROCEDURES

UF GME programs will follow all policies and procedures outlined by the University of Florida's Office for Accessibility and Gender Equity regarding accommodations for disabilities.
